Stalin rise to power

The Soviet Union was in turmoil:

- Suffering from a famine that lasted two years.
- Left Wing was Trotsky = Wanted permanent revolution
- Right Wing was Bukharin = Wanted to consolidate Soviet power in Russia:
‘socialism in one country’
 - Bukharin still wanted to uphold the NEP even if it was causing an increase in Kulaks

Trotsky, Kamenev and Zinoviev and then Bukharin were voted off the Politburo

Stalin rise to power

NEP: New Economic Policy (1922 - 1928) = Mixed economy system (Capitalist State within communist USSR)

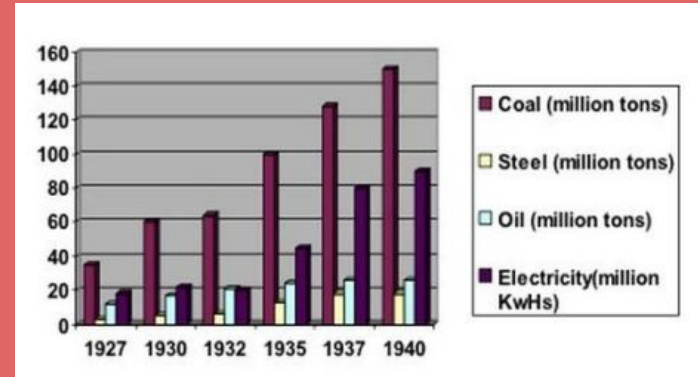
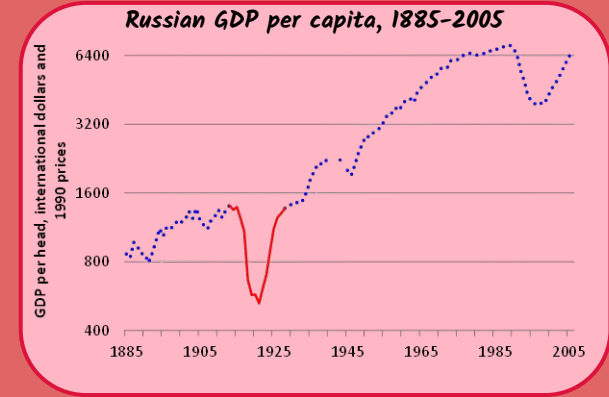
- State controlled banks
- Foreign Trade
- Private individuals could own little enterprises.

This was abolished by Stalin in 1928

- Collectivization of Soviet agriculture
- Large-scale industrialization



A Summary of Totalitarian Tactics in Crisis

- A Economic Crisis = Political Crisis
- Political crisis=Political Opportunities
- Fear and Want for Expansion from Population=Support for Totalitarian Parties
- Support for Totalitarian Parties+Political Opportunities=Rise of Totalitarian Leader
- Rise of Totalitarian Leader=Totalitarian Policies

And finally with a Totalitarian Leader and Totalitarian Policies, the regime has become completely entrenched within the region.
